**WHEREAS**, the Whale Pond Brook Watershed Association (WPBWA) is in the process of applying to the Monmouth County Historic Preservation Commission for funding under its 2017-18 Historic Preservation Grant Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the focus of this grant is to begin the restoration of the 117- year-old stone hut located on Ross Island. This grant is to replace roof mortar and stones to preserve the integrity of the roof; and

**WHEREAS**, matching funds of 50% are required in order for the WPBWA to obtain grant funding of \$5,000 from the Monmouth County Historic Preservation Grant Program, of which half of the requisite match may be local; and

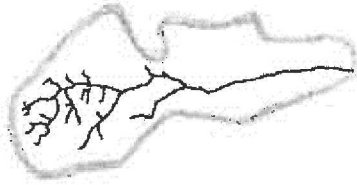

The County will provide half of the funds and the City is asked to match. The City's match is \$5,000.

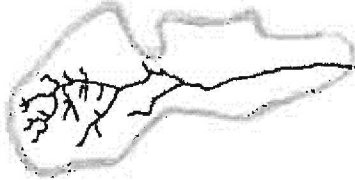
Attached is the Draft Resolution for the \$5,000 grant match. All costs will be available for discussion at the Council workshop.

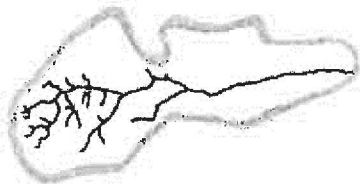
This historic postcard, looking southeast, shows the Ross estate with a bridge to the hut.

The 2014 Phase I grant removed trees and shrubs on the eastern side intertwined in the roof mortar to preserve the integrity of the roof.

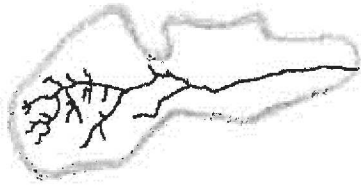

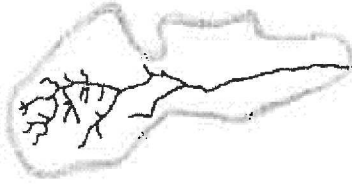
**Phase II**

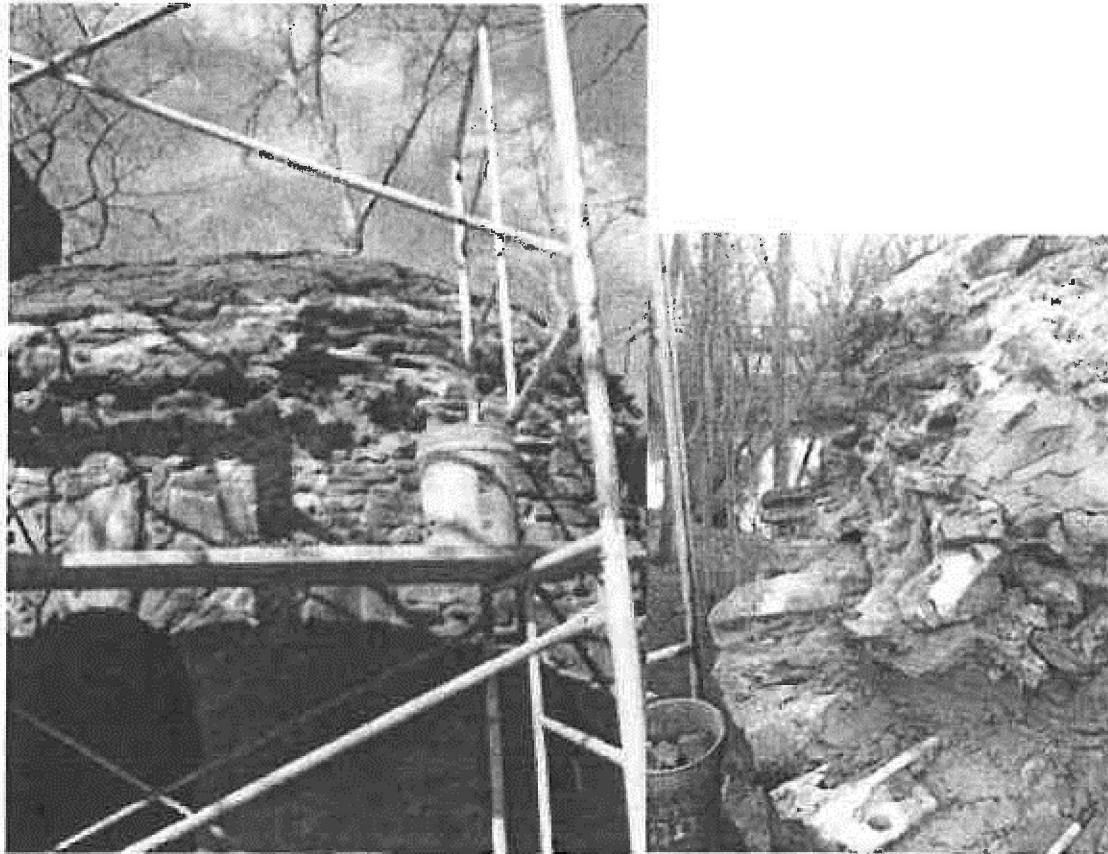


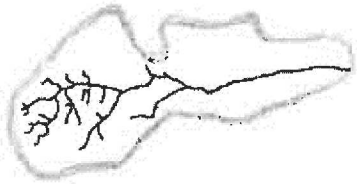

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**Phase III**

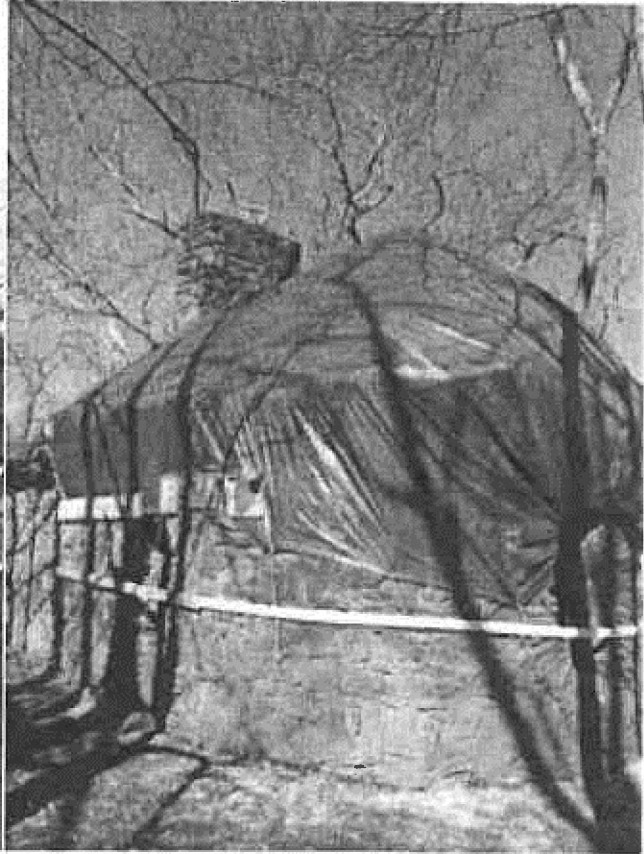
There was extensive damage to the unprotected east side. Remaining stones were replaced and mortar was put on to stabilize the remaining surface stone. A tarp was securely wrapped around the eastern half of the structure. This protection will remain until funds are secured to finish the project.

**After meeting Ms. Teitelbaum and visiting the site of the Stone Hut I recommend the following :**

**Power wash existing Stone Hut including roof and all sides to rid of all moss, dirt, plant life and debris. This will further illustrate areas in need of attention and repair, aside from the obvious faults and visible damage. Scaffolding will be erected on all sides to the roof line to prepare the areas for repair. Missing peanut stone on roof and various areas on surface of Stone Hut will be replaced. Mortar consisting of a larger aggregate stone texture and consistency will be used in order to try to match the original look. Various cracks on exterior and interior walls will be cut out and repacked with the same texturized mortar. After all surface repairs are completed, the roof will be treated with a spray coating of waterproofing silicone to deter leakage and erosion from the elements.**

**Due to the location of the Stone Hut, performing these repairs presents some unique challenges. All materials, such as a generator, sand, cement, scaffolding, tools, water and other items needed will**



have to be brought ashore via raft or boat and stored for the duration of the repair timeline. After completion of the repairs all will have to be brought back. The estimation of completing this work weather permitting is 10 to 12 working days which will include the prep and staging of materials.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MONMOUTH COUNTY  
MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL COASTAL FLOOD EVACUATION PLAN (CFEP)  
AS PART OF LONG BRANCH EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Monmouth County remains highly vulnerable to flooding and susceptible to damage associated with coastal storm events; and

**WHEREAS**, some of the county's most densely populated areas and seasonally dependent businesses are located within 1- mile of the coast with densities in some places exceeding 5,000 people per square mile; and

**WHEREAS**, the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management, with assistance from the Monmouth County Division of Planning and Manasquan Borough Office of Emergency Management, has developed a Multi-Jurisdictional Coastal Flood Evacuation Plan (CFEP) to improve response and coordination among local, state, and county agencies responsible for emergency operations involving floods; and

**WHEREAS**, the Multi-Jurisdictional Coastal Flood Evacuation Plan provides flood monitoring, warning, evacuation and response guidance for major coastal flood events resulting from both tropical cyclones and extra-tropical storm events such as nor'easters for Monmouth County and all of its affected municipalities; and

**WHEREAS**, the CFEP was developed using established National Weather Service Sea, Lake and Overland Surges from Hurricanes (SLOSH) model inundation areas in order to assist decision makers in determining appropriate evacuation strategies and proper allocation of high water response resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the multi-tiered evacuation zones presented in the CFEP are based on predicted storm surge events issued by the National Weather Service and are the basis for the "Know Your Zone" public education and awareness campaign to improve the storm readiness for residents, businesses, and visitors in Monmouth County; and

**WHEREAS**, municipalities that adopt the Multi-Jurisdictional Coastal Flood Evacuation Plan and participate in the National Flood Insurance Program's (NFIP) Community Rating System (CRS) program may be eligible for additional CRS credits in accordance Section 610, Flood Warning and Response, of the NFIP Community Rating System Coordinator's Manual; and

**WHEREAS**, municipalities that wish to earn additional credits towards CRS through adoption of the CFEP must develop their own individual Flood Warning & Response Plan, which at a minimum, must include all of the following action items:

1. Flood Threat Recognition (CRS 612.a): Municipal Coordinators/deputies must enroll in both INWS and the Stevens Flood Advisory System;
2. Description of Local Flood Hazard (CRS 611.b): # structures, residences, buildings,

critical facilities in each zone and local impacts if flooded;

3. Emergency Warning Dissemination (612.b): Activation of local warning systems based upon flood threat. Such warning may include pre-scripted messages, Reverse911, Outdoor Siren System, Route Alerting (door-to-door) etc.;

4. Flood Response Operations (CRS 612.c): Local actions to be taken based upon flood threat. (ie: closing roads, relocating critical equipment to higher ground, open shelters/reception areas, etc.) as well a local person/Office/Department assigned to implement each action;

5. Critical Facilities Planning CRS 612.d): Critical Facilities must be identified in each zone, with contact information and a plan to notify them when appropriate; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to be eligible to received credits earned under CRS 610, municipalities must complete the following tasks:

- Pass a resolution adopting the Monmouth County CFEP and incorporate the Municipal Flood Warning & Response Plan into the Evacuation Annex of the municipal Emergency Operations Plan (EOP)
- Participate in an annual drill or exercise of the Flood Warning & Response Plan or participate in at least one an actual event during the year which results in activation of the Flood Warning & Response Plan
- Undertake one or more public Outreach Projects that address the local Flood Warning & Response Plan

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that governing body of Long Branch hereby supports adoption of the Monmouth County Multi-Jurisdictional Coastal Flood Evacuation Plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Long Branch develop and incorporate a Municipal Flood Warning & Response Plan into the Evacuation Annex of the municipal Emergency Operations Plan (EOP); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Long Branch will support Monmouth County efforts with the "Know Your Zone" public education and awareness campaign.

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2017, the City Council adopted a resolution regarding Municipal Open Space Program – Florence Avenue Park – Program Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Open Space committee requested that several modifications be made to the initial application and re-submit before October 27, 2017 in order to be considered for the 2017 grant award cycle.

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders has approved an Open Space Trust Fund and established a Municipal Open Space Program to provide Program Grant funds in connection with municipal acquisition of lands for County park, recreation, conservation and farmland preservation purposes, as well as for County recreation and conservation development and maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of The City of Long Branch desires to obtain County Open Space Trust Funds in the amount of \$31,105.80 to fund Various Upgrades to the Florence Avenue Park (proposed) at 271 Florence Avenue (Block 395 Lot 1); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project including all matching funds is \$62,211.60; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Branch is the owner of and controls the project site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Long Branch THAT:

1. Adam Schneider, Mayor or his/her successor is authorized to (a) make an application to the County of Monmouth for Open Space Trust Funds, (b) provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required for the Municipal Open Space Grants Program and (c) act as the municipal contact person and correspondent of the above-named municipality; and
2. The City of Long Branch is committed to this project and will provide the balance of funding necessary to complete the project as described in the grant application in the form of non-county matching funds as required in the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Program; and

If the County of Monmouth determines that the application is complete and in conformance with the Monmouth County Municipal Open Space Program and the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Municipal Grants Program adopted thereto, the municipality is willing to use the approved Open Space Trust Funds in accordance with such policies and procedures, and applicable federal, state, and local government rules, regulations and statutes thereto; and

4. Adam Schneider, Mayor or his/her successor is hereby authorized to sign and execute any required documents, agreements, and amendments thereto with the County of Monmouth for the approved Open Space Trust Funds; and
